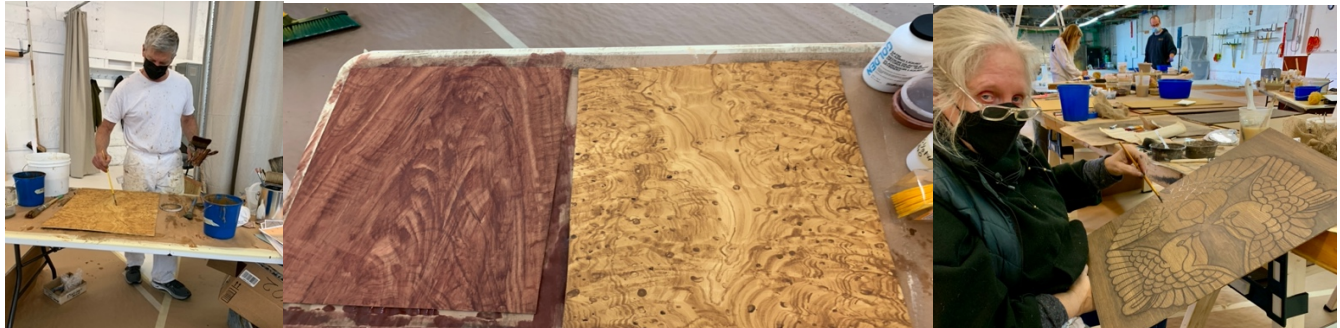
FAUX FINISHES: WOODGRAINING

In this seminar, students will explore various woodgraining methods, painting samples on hard panels. Students will practice with different wood colors and grains; lectures will include the nature and growth of Wood, demonstration of lay-in and graining; application of glazes, aging, faux carving, and moldings.

Cost of the 3-day Woodgraining course is \$475 for the November 11 and 12 classes and \$675 for all three classes, which includes all materials. Returning students get a \$25 discount.
